Qualifications: It is essential that you hold a minimum of a BACP accredited Diploma in Counselling qualification.

Experience:

Experience of counselling young people 16+ is essential. The preferred candidate will also be a strong team player and be comfortable with lone working. They will have effective communication and interpersonal skills and be able to demonstrate excellent organisational skills and time management ensuring effective prioritisation. The candidate must also have a confidential / compassionate approach and have strong risk management skills.
